Like most of us, Eric started in magic at a very early age. When he was 10, a magician came to his school and he thought to himself, "That's what I want to do!" He immediately went down to his local library and started reading all about magic and related arts. His first "professional" show was at age 11 in the basement of his church. He was booked for a 1/2 hour and was so nervous that he did the whole show(20 some tricks) in less than 15 minutes. There was an auction following the show and he bid on a rabbit. Much to his mother's chagrin, he won it and has never stopped the magic thing.

He started doing shows all over the area, from churches to schools; to shopping malls and restaurants. His mother would assist him(loading the birds and such) and she would take him all over the country to different magic conventions. He considers this time of "meeting the masters" the best opportunity of his career.

Since then, he has performed all over the world with his act of comedy, magic & juggling. He opened up Sesame Place Amusement park as their house magician, was the star of a show at The Aruba Concorde Hotel & Casino and was a bartender magician for many years in between the "big" gigs.

Approximately three years ago, Eric decided to concentrate his efforts on nothing but magic and went into performing full-time. With much advertising and promotion, he has risen to doing 50 shows a month all within the Philadelphia area! I'd say it was a good choice to go full-time. He recently wrote a course on children's entertaining for magicians that is selling very well and publishes a monthly newsletter online called "Success in Magic".

Apart from the magic business, Eric is very involved in the community. He is involved at his church as an usher and children's teacher. He volunteers at local prisons and institutions.
